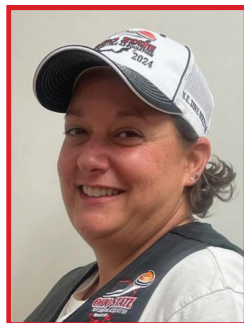

I, for myself, my heirs, successors, beneficiaries, executors and subrogees, hereby knowingly and intentionally waive and release, indemnity and hold harmless the Ohio Trapshooting Association, Inc., its directors, officers, agents, employees, and volunteers, from and against any and all claims, actions, causes of action, liabilities, suits, expenses, and dangers including personal injury and death sustained/incurred by myself or which I cause to others, which are related to, arise out of, or are in any way connected with my attendance or participation at this Tournament.*

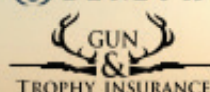

# SHOOTER INFORMATION

1. Targets will be shot 5 per post, 25 per trap, 12 banks. Doubles shot 25 pair per trap.
2. Squadding will be restricted to a maximum of a 2 yard difference on a squad.
3. **REDUCED PRICE YOUTH TARGETS:** The O.S.T.A. and MidwayUSA are proud to offer all Junior and Sub-Junior shooters, reduced price entry for all events during the 2025 Ohio State Shoot. Junior and Sub-Junior shooters will be charged \$35.00 per hundred, plus daily A.T.A. and O.S.T.A. fees on all events beginning Tuesday, June 17th. (Targets only - no options).
4. **No entry will be changed after the participant has left the cashiering window. Targets not cashiered prior to shooting an event will count as "targets only" and the shooter will be ineligible for all trophies, options and added money for the event. The targets will be registered and the shooter will be required to pay all target fees and ATA/OSTA fees for the event. Shooter will NOT be allowed to shoot remaining events until restitution is made for those targets. Multiple occurrences will result in disqualification.**

## I. CLASSIFICATION/HANDICAPPING

- A. Handicapping and Classification will be determined by the State Directors or qualified appointed personnel.
- B. Shooters are required to have both their 16-yard average and doubles average computed, for use by the Handicapping Committee, on the targets they have shot for the current year. The standard system will be used, whereby shooters will be classified on known ability and their official 16-yard and doubles averages.

- C. Shooter Handicap yardage and Singles/Doubles classification will be determined at the Central Entry Building (CEB) Classification Counter. **Also at this time, any category declaration must be made.** No shooter will be allowed to declare a special category after the first shot is fired in the event by the contestant. For purposes of special category declaration, **the time of entry is when you are classified.**

Husband/Wife, Parent/Child, Grandparent/Grandchild, and Directors' Cup participants must register at the O.S.T.A. Hall of Fame Museum for Saturday's Singles Championship **by 10:00 am Saturday.** Attention Singles and Doubles Zone Team Members & Alternates: No sign-in is required or reporting to the CEB. Your scores will automatically be pulled from the computer as needed.

### THE ABOVE IS SOLELY THE SHOOTER'S RESPONSIBILITY

- D. **TARGET REQUIREMENTS:** Shot during period between September 1, 2023 & June 17, 2025.  
 16-yard ~ 1000 registered: Penalty B (min. one class move up with a min. class B)  
 Handicap ~ 1000 registered: Penalty - 2 yard min., not to exceed 25 yards, or current yardage, whichever is greater.  
 Doubles ~ 500 registered: Penalty B (min. one class move up with a min. class B)
- E. **EXCEPTIONS** - Handicap penalty yardage is waived for this shoot for Sr. Veterans and Lady II shooters age 65 and older. Any shooter having won or tied their class beginning with Event 4 at the 2025 Ohio State Shoot, must move up at least one class during the 2025 Ohio State Shoot. Any shooter having won or tied their class beginning with Event 4 of the current shoot, must move up at least one class prior to the next event. Scores will be disqualified for any shooter not in compliance.
- F. Classification changes made during the shoot will be posted on the wall of the CEB and will be considered official when posted.

## II. SQUADDING

- A. No entry fee refunds, (including options and purses), unless an event is cancelled. Postponed events are not cancelled events and are not subject to refunds.
- B. There will be a \$25.00 re-entry fee on all events.
- C. Do not enter a late squad in one event and an early squad in the next event on the same day.
- D. A shooter may not make up more than 50 targets on the practice traps if shooter misses squad. Shooter will have to be re-squadded. Make-ups, for broken guns or missing a squad, must be shot at practice traps within 30 minutes after the completion of each event.
- E. Event entries close when the last squad takes the firing line. Please be aware of the operating hours of the CEB.
- F. PRESQUADDING is available only on-line at [www.rjstuart.com](http://www.rjstuart.com), with a credit card.

## III. TROPHIES/SHOOTOFFS

- A. **TOTAL TROPHIES.....Over 700 Trophies and Awards**
- B. All ties in singles and doubles carry over to the next singles and doubles event unless otherwise noted. All other trophy ties will be shot off at the end of each day unless otherwise stated. If necessary, ties may be carried over to the next corresponding event, be shot off concurrently in succeeding events, or at a time designated by the Directors. Anyone in a tie who leaves the grounds or does not answer a call will forfeit his/her rights to shoot off. In the event that shooters are called for a shoot-off and then the shoot-off cannot be concluded (ex. time limitations, weather conditions), only those shooters who have checked in will be eligible for trophies. For any shoot-off that is not concluded, winners will be determined by long run from front, and ties will be determined by a coin flip performed by a tournament official.

- C. **CATEGORY SHOOTERS:** At all tournaments where All American points will be awarded in any event, shooters may declare only one category (i.e. Lady I, Lady II, Sub-Junior, Junior, Junior Gold, Sub-Veteran, Veteran, or Senior Veteran) Note: Chair shooters are exempt from this rule.

Any shooter who is tied for event Champion may shoot-off/carry-over for the Championship trophy. If a shooter fails in the championship trophy shoot-off/carry-over and has declared a special category at the time of classification, the shooter can fall back to the declared category. Any shooter who has declared a special category at the time of classification and whose score qualifies for any trophy in his/her declared category, will compete for the category trophy and not for place, class or yardage group. Any special category shooter, whose score does not qualify for a trophy in his/her category, may compete for place, class or yardage group trophies.

**Once any declarations have been made either by shooter or shoot management, the declaration is final and cannot be changed. There shall be no exception to this rule.**

All Lady I, Lady II, Sub-Veteran, Veteran, Sr. Veteran, Junior Gold, Junior, Sub-Junior must declare their special category at the time of classification in any registered tournament if they wish to compete as a category shooter. **Without such declaration, the contestant will not be allowed to compete for the applicable category trophy for the duration of the tournament.** No contestant will be allowed to declare or change a special declaration after firing his/her first shot. There will be no exceptions to this rule. **Failure to declare your classification does not constitute an A.T.A. classification error. Please check your classification receipt before leaving the classification desk.**

- D. **All shootoffs will be announced and held at the discretion of the O.S.T.A. Board of Directors, and will cease at 10 p.m.**

E. Eligibility:	<b>LADY I Trophies</b> <i>must be 54 and under</i>	<b>SENIOR VETERAN Trophies</b> <i>must be 70 or over</i>
	<b>LADY II Trophies</b> <i>must be 55 and over</i>	<b>SUB-JUNIOR Trophies</b> <i>must not have reached 15th birthday</i>
	<b>SUB-VET Trophies</b> <i>must be age 55-64</i>	<b>JUNIOR Trophies</b> <i>must be 15 but not reached 18th birthday</i>
	<b>VETERAN Trophies</b> <i>must be 65 or over</i>	<b>JUNIOR GOLD Trophies</b> <i>must be 18-22</i>

Shooters who become eligible for new age based categories during the target year may elect to continue to compete in the previous category for the remainder of that target year. However, once a shooter has elected to move to the new category, that decision is irrevocable and he/she may not again declare eligibility for the previous category.

#### IV. SHOOTER SERVICES

- A. CEB will be open for classification, squadding and cashing on Monday from 2:00 p.m. to 5:00 p.m.; open 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. Tuesday through Friday; 7:30 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. on Saturday, and 7:30 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. on Sunday.
- B. Practice traps will be open on Monday, June 17, from 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. Practice trap fee - \$7.00 per 25 targets or 12 pair doubles. One practice trap will be kept open for next day's first event for 30 minutes after the last event's last squad has taken the line. (Exception -- make-ups).
- C. Line supervisors may be called for any questionable change of score on the score sheets.
- D. Empty hulls may not be picked up on the firing line.
- E. First Aid on duty during entire program.

- A. ATA Rules will govern all events and decisions will be based accordingly.
- B. Purses are not compulsory. Consult your various program events for option(s) and added money information.
- C. This is an Invitational Tournament and the Directors reserve the right to reject, refund or disqualify any contestant who in their judgment interferes with the harmony of the shoot or violates ATA rules and regulations. ***A shooter using abusive language to trap help will be removed from the competition.*** The Directors reserve the right to alter or cancel any part of this program for good and sufficient reasons.
- D. Use of factory loaded ammunition is not compulsory. You may use reloads providing they conform with all ATA rules. All shells are subject to inspection at the discretion of the Directors. Shells will be available at prevailing prices. Any Vendor who wishes to sell shells may do so.
- E. No soliciting.
- F. It is each contestant's responsibility to check their score before moving to the next post and have any errors corrected at that time. After this point, sheets cannot be changed. Furthermore, all contestants must verify their scores and special category when posted on the official scoreboard each day since all trophies, options, and prize monies are awarded on the scores shown thereon. ***Scores are final (for purse and options) 2 hours after posting.***

- H. **ANNUAL MEETING of the O.S.T.A. GUN CLUB MEMBERSHIP:**

To receive the annual trophy package that is offered by the O.S.T.A., a club representative must attend.  
This is an important general business meeting featuring the nomination of the A.T.A. Delegate (and Alternate Delegates), and the O.S.T.A. Director-at-Large.
- I. ELECTIONS: Saturday, June 21, 2025, voting will be at the CEB from 10:00 am to 2:00 pm. Your A.T.A number is required,  
There will be a \$25.00 charge for each bad check written. No counter checks or second party checks will be accepted by cashiers. Checks will be accepted for amount of shooting fees only.

# 2024 HALL OF FAME INDUCTEES

## Ronald W. Comerford

IN 1934, RONALD COMERFORD WAS BORN IN CLEVELAND, and he resided in Boardman. He was a 1952 graduate from West Technical High School and attended Baldwin-Wallace College in Berea. He was an engineer by trade and an avid trapshooter.

In 1958 at the age of 24, he was stuffing paper wads into Federal paper hulls working on producing 100 shells for the next day. The tedious reloading on his Acme press using 4 separate pieces of cardboard to make a wad column in the shell, got this engineer wishing for a better design. He had to find some way to have a plastic sealing and something in the middle to absorb some of the shock. Ronald sketched out a design and had it produced at a plastics company in Cleveland. A single-cavity mold which produced 32 wads per molding was developed. His prototype worked almost perfectly the first time! His new plastic wads were a sensation that revolutionized and changed shooting forever. This miraculous invention, a one-piece, all plastic shotshell cup wad, modernized reloading and brought more consistency to shotshell patterns. Ron established a company called RonCO Distributors. For a while, he sold Ford wads which were similar to the configuration of the Winchester AA wad but yellow.

Ron and his wife Peggy were lifelong world travelers. After retirement, he also enjoyed riding his Suzuki motorcycle with a sidecar for his gun & gear, fishing, and sail boating. Ron said, "the wad was my 15 minutes of fame!". Plastic shotgun wads have not changed much from the "red radishes" he first produced from red plastic and his shotgun wad is the standard still in use today. Ron's philosophy of life was "to live according to the Book and try to be a decent man". Ron passed away on January 23, 2024.

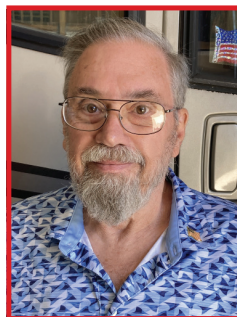


## Robert J. Stuart

IT WAS AT A LOCAL GUN CLUB on a Sunday when 13-year-old Bob Stuart was introduced to shooting trap. Like so many trapshooters, it all started with a family member (Uncle Frank) taking them out with a borrowed gun (a Mossberg 16-gauge pump), and the rest is history. However, in 1972, his shooting was put on hold for college. After studying theater arts and broadcasting, he travelled a lot working as a stagehand and road crew for several bands.

In the early 1980's, Bob became interested in computers and bought a computer store in the Buffalo area. He began shooting at the local gun club and was elected to their board of directors. It was in 1986 while hosting a large, 2-day registered shoot at the club, Bob realized the need for a computer for trapshooting events. This prompted him to write software code to register shooters and run shoot operations. His software could produce a high gun list and calculate options with speed and accuracy. This was the start of Bob's career cashiering shoots. In 1989, he was hired by Elwood "Woody" Brown to run computer operations in Pennsylvania. Bob was the code writer but Woody had many of the ideas and was instrumental in promoting his computer system. Bob continued to upgrade his system and integrated it with cashiering.

In January 1993 while in Georgia cashiering the Dixie Grand, Mr. Bopp and Mr. Bradford of the Amateur Trapshooting Association approached Bob asking him to run the Grand American that year. Bob was stunned by the invitation and gladly accepted. The following year was the first year his system was used by the Ohio State Trapshooting Association and has been in place for over 30 years.
